

Smart Flu Vaccines

Default Vision Screen Set up

If you are experiencing problems with using Smart Flu Vaccines and the script is displaying the wrong dialogue boxes, this could be down to the type of view you are currently using.

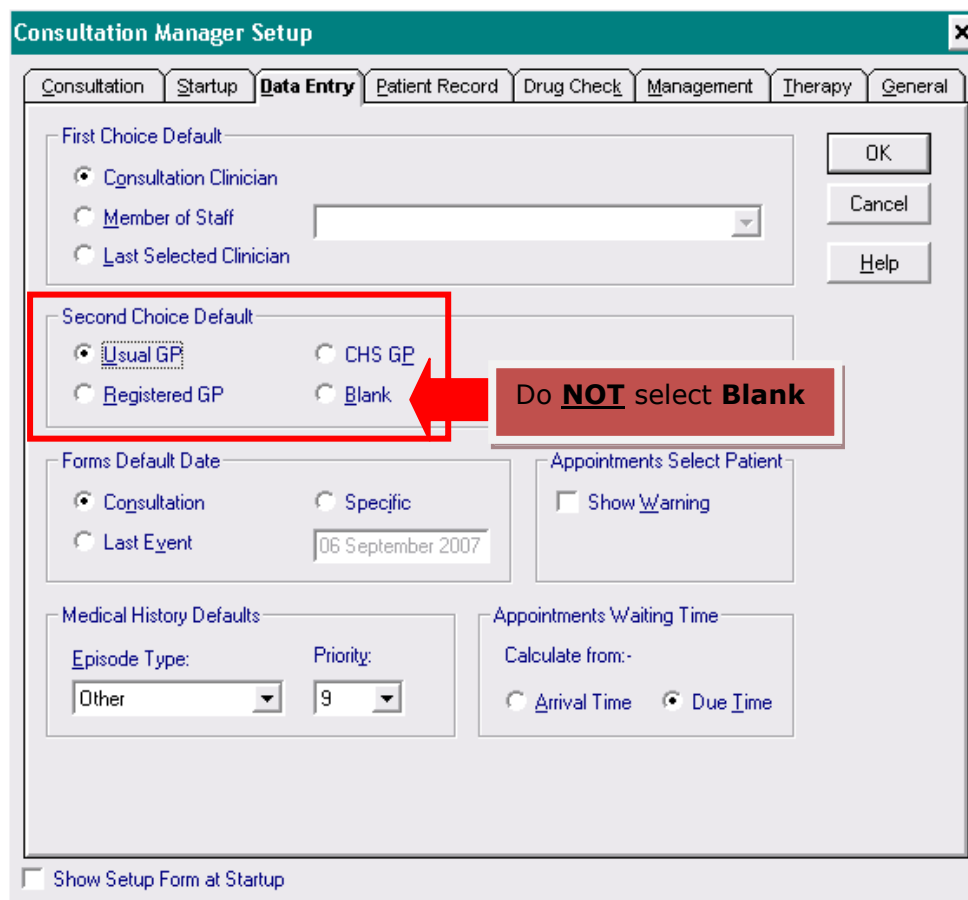
To check this could you just temporarily change your screen view to a default view to see if this rectifies the problem. If it does, please use this view when using Smart Flu Vaccines and change it back after the flu clinic is over if you wish.

The reason for this is because each user/practice can customise each tab for the patient view and use shortcut keys that may be being used by Smart Flu Vaccines. It is impossible to cover every eventuality of different screen set ups.

However it is very easy to jump from one screen to another.

Change to the Default View

1. Open Consultation Manager (do not select a patient)
2. Click on the Consultation menu (top left corner of screen) > scroll down to Options > Setup...
3. The Data Entry screen must NOT have "Blank" selected under the Second Choice Default. As this will cause scripts to fail as no clinician name will be entered in the script.

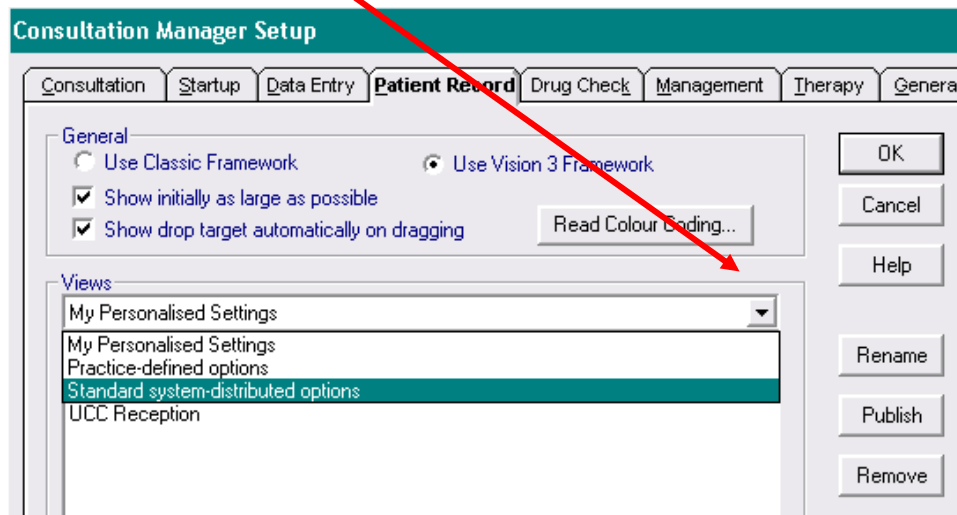

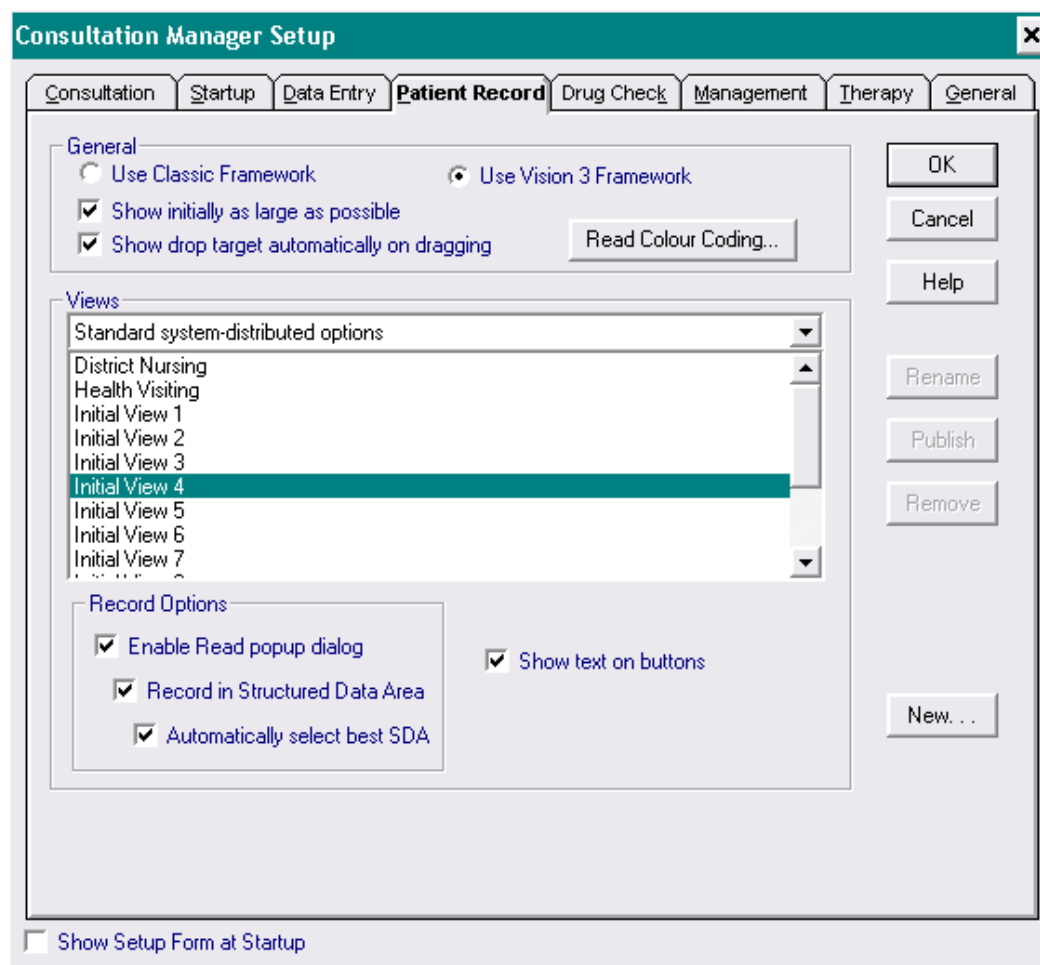

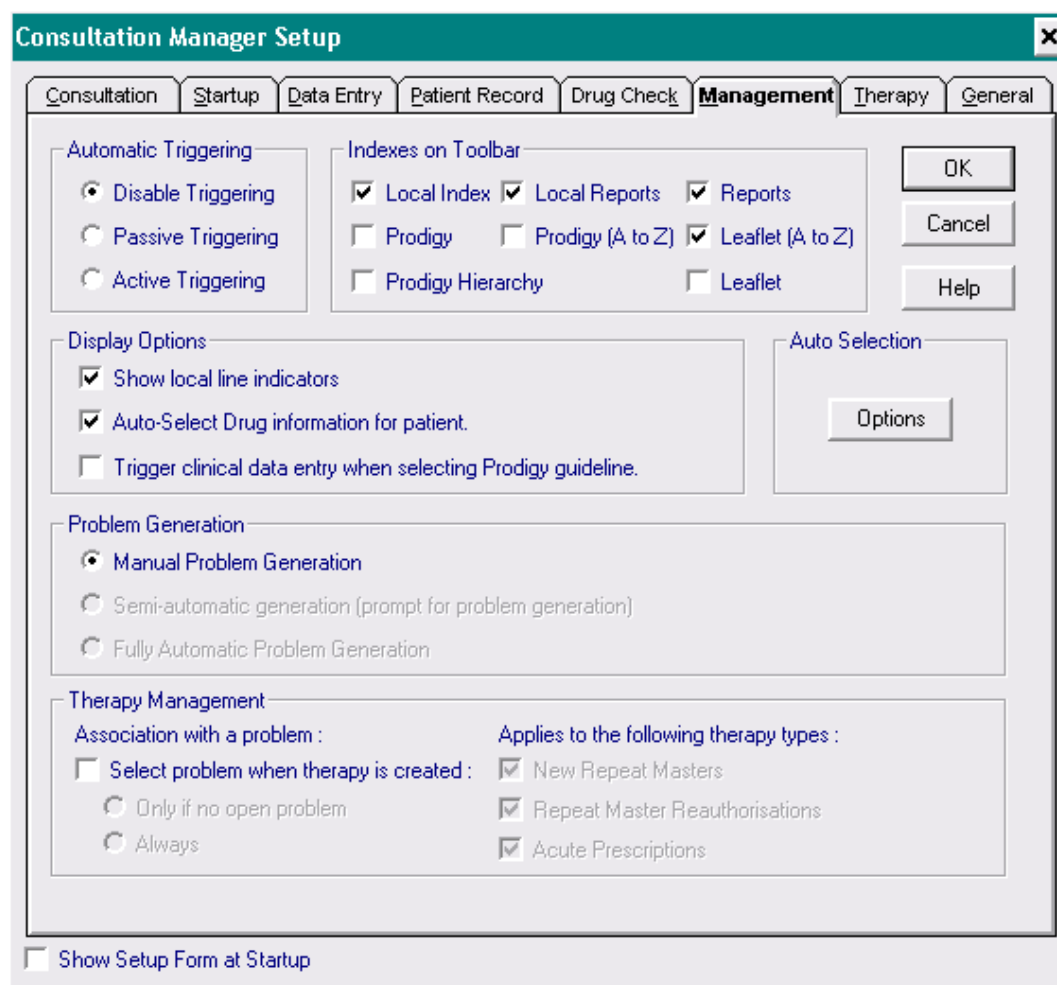

6. The Management tab should look exactly like this:

You will notice that all Prodigy references have been removed and this has nothing actually to do with Smart Flu Vaccines, but while you are here you might as well remove all references as it has been discontinued, most of the information is years out of date and it will soon be removed by INPS anyway.

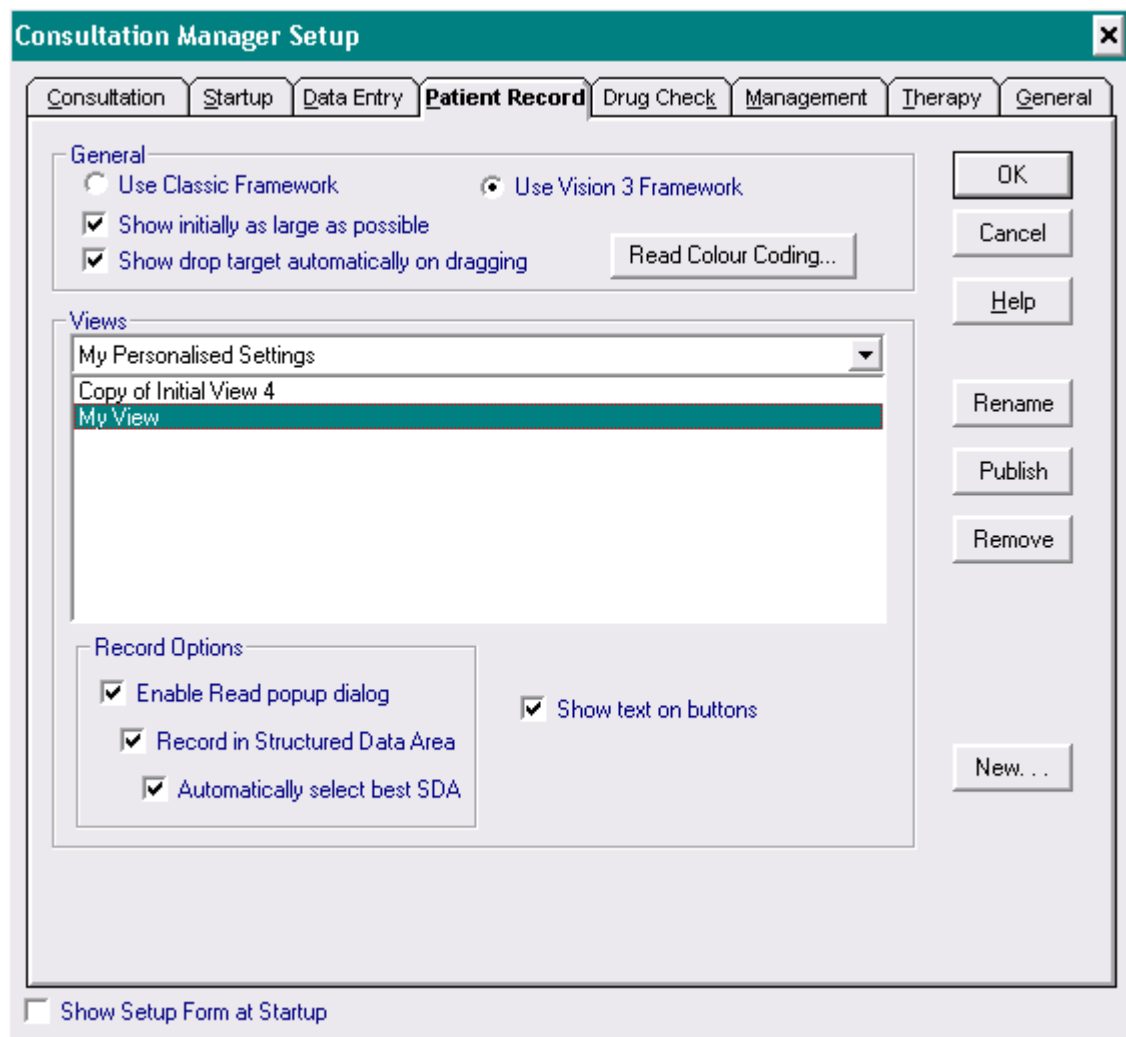
8. Click OK to save changes

Now try using Smart Flu Vaccines to see if this rectifies any issues.

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To restore your original screen set up

1. Open Consultation Manager (do not select a patient)
2. Click on the Consultation menu (top left corner of screen) > scroll down to Options > Setup...
3. Select the Patient Record tab

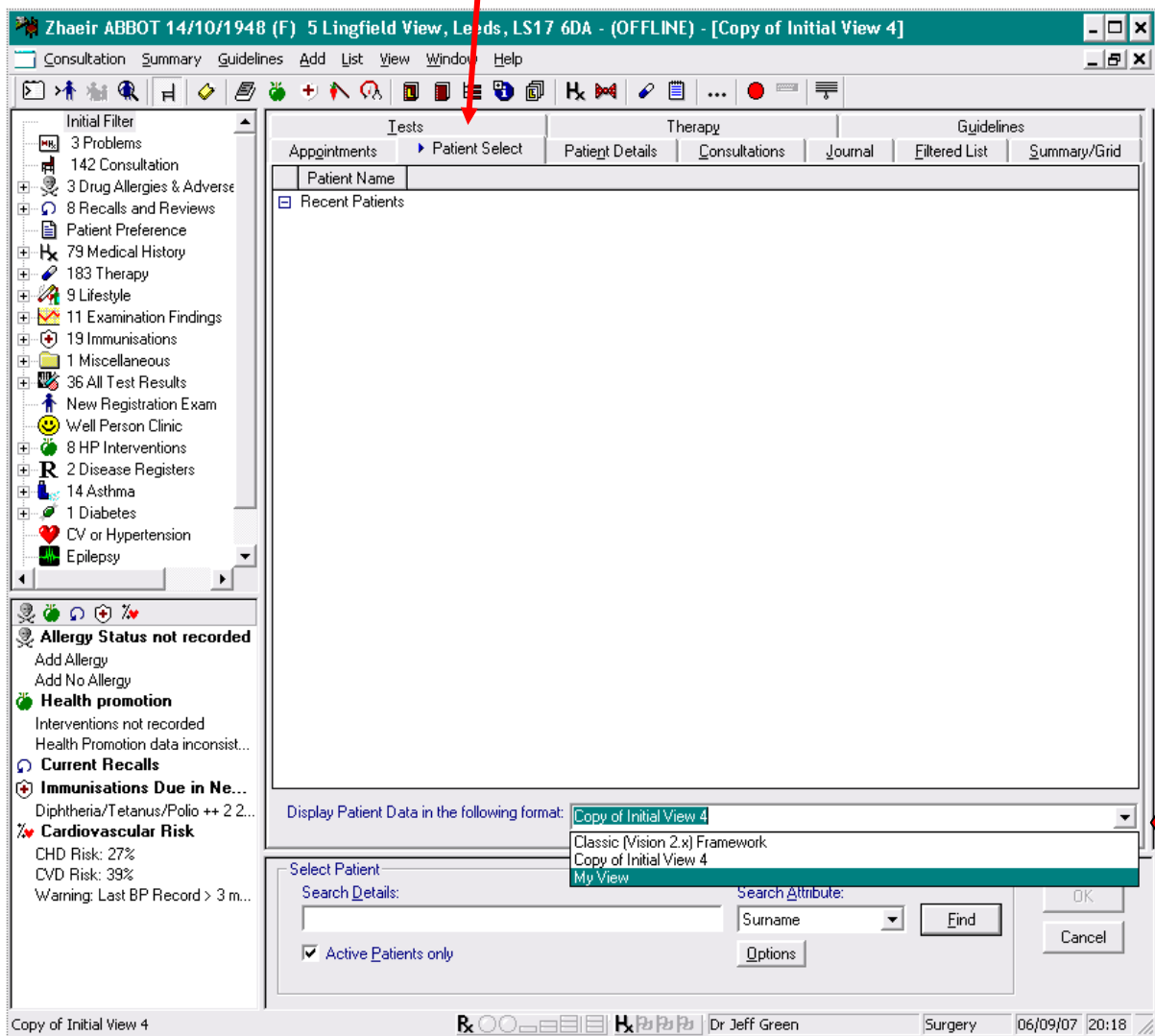
